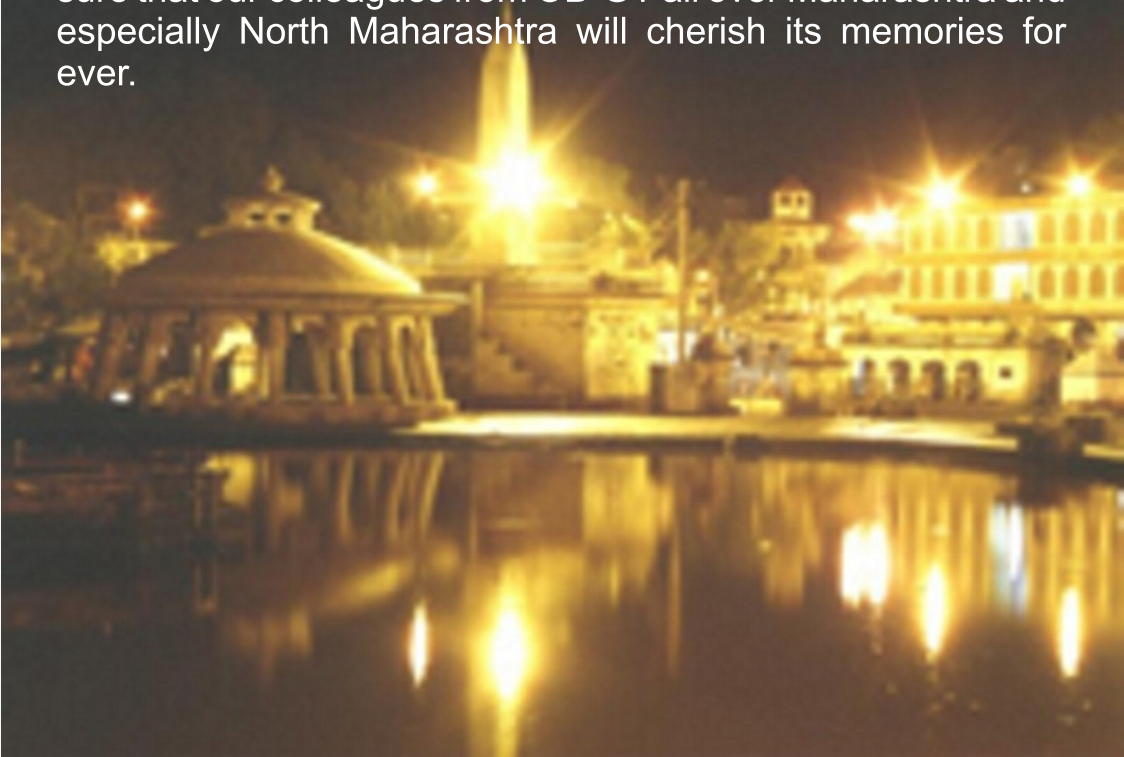


About the Conference
